Confirmation of the Minutes of the seventeenth Meeting of the Building and Works Committee held on 23.12,2021.

The minutes of seventeenth BWC meeting held on 23.12.2021 were confirmed.

- Action Taken Report on the decisions of the seventeenth meeting of the BWC

 The Committee noted the Actions taken report as placed before it. For the waterbody development work, the committee further advised the Institute for exploring the possibility of introducing a spillover weir type structure or a sluice gate type structure at the exit point of the main natural 'Nalla' of the campus to prevent backflow during monsoon/ flood time. This however may be planned only after thorough observations of the flows through the Nalla during rainy seasons.
- Item No. 3 Allotment of work for Construction of a 96 Seater Boys Hostel & Extension of the Girls Hostel at IIIT Guwahati permanent campus Bongora, under Kamrup (R) District, Guwahati:

The committee was apprised about the background of estimates and the tendering details.

The committee then examined the reports (Technical report & the Financial report with CS) of the bid evaluation committee and noted that out of 5 bids, 3 qualified technically. All the qualified bidders have quoted competitive bids for the work. The lowest bidder M/s Bikash Enterprises is 1.4% higher than the estimated, while that of 2nd lowest M/s TRICON is 3% above estimate and that of M/s Shree Gautam is 5% above estimate. It is further noted that while rates in some items of the lowest bidder are lower than the estimated, in some other parts/items rates are higher than the estimated. However, in totality his bid appears to be balanced.

After threadbare discussions on the issue, the **Committee resolved to allot the work to the lowest bidder M/s Bikash Enterprises** at his quoted price of Rs.6,25,25,481/-
