



### **Guidelines for the On-campus Hostel Accommodation Allotment for 1<sup>st</sup> Year B.Tech Students**

Due to the limited availability of on-campus hostel accommodation at IIIT Guwahati, it may not be possible to accommodate all first-year B. Tech students within the campus. Accordingly, the following guidelines shall be followed for the allotment of hostel on-campus accommodation:

#### **I. Girl Students and Persons with Disabilities (PwD)**

- a. All girls and PwD students shall be allotted accommodation in the on-campus.

#### **III. Room Allocation**

- a. Hostel rooms shall be allotted on a sharing basis (2 or 3 students per room).
- b. Some students may be allotted accommodation with attached washroom facilities, while others may be provided accommodation with common washroom facilities, subject to availability.

#### **IV. Preparation of Hostel Allotment List**

- a. Rooms/beds shall be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis according to the chronological order of admission confirmation and hostel reporting.

#### **V. Allocation of On-Campus Hostel Accommodation**

- a. Approximately 160 male students, shall be accommodated in the on-campus boys' hostel. However, all girls will be accommodated in the on-campus.
- b. After allocating accommodation to students (male) belonging to the PwD category, the remaining hostel accommodation shall be allotted to other students in accordance with the reservation and quota policies of the Government of India.
- c. Students who cannot be accommodated on campus shall be provided with information regarding the **empanelled Paying Guest (PG)** accommodation facilities arranged by the Institute within approximately 6.5 km from the institute. However, availing the **empanelled PG** accommodation is not compulsory for first-year students. Students whose parents/guardians can arrange suitable alternative accommodation may opt out of the empanelled PG facility.

#### **VI. Acceptance of Allotted Accommodation.**

- d. Students shall be required to accept the hostel room allotted to them.
- e. Requests for a change of room or hostel accommodation from students or their parents/guardians shall ordinarily not be entertained during the allotment process.

#### **VII. Mutual Room Exchange**

- a. After completion of the admission process and after students have had sufficient time to familiarize themselves with the hostel environment, requests for mutual room exchange may be considered by the hostel authorities, subject to the approval of the concerned Warden.

#### **VIII. Future On-Campus Accommodation**

- a. Students who are unable to secure on-campus hostel accommodation during their first year shall be provided on-campus hostel accommodation from the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester (second year) onwards, subject to the Institute's hostel allotment policy.

**The decision of the Institute regarding hostel accommodation allotment shall be final and binding on all students.**
