



Guidelines for the Hostel On-campus Accommodation Allotment for 1st Year B.Tech Students

Due to the limited availability of on-campus hostel accommodation at IIIT Guwahati, it may not be possible to accommodate all first-year B. Tech students within the campus. Accordingly, the following guidelines shall be followed for the allotment of hostel on-campus accommodation:

I. Girl Students; Persons with Disabilities (PwD); and DASA candidates

- a. All female students and Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidates will be provided with on-campus hostel accommodation.
- b. Ten (10) hostel seats will be reserved for DASA candidates.

II. Allocation of On-Campus Hostel Accommodation

- a. Hostel rooms shall be allotted on a sharing basis (2 or 3 students per room).
- b. Some students may be allotted accommodation with attached washroom facilities, while others may be provided accommodation with common washroom facilities, subject to availability.
- c. Approximately 160 hostel seats will be allotted for male students. After accommodating all eligible PwD male candidates within these 160 seats, the remaining seats will be allotted to other students in accordance with the Government of India reservation policy, i.e. EWS=10%; OBC= 27%; OC/UR= 40.5%; SC= 15%; ST= 7.5%.
- d. On-campus hostel accommodation shall be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis, following the chronological order of admission confirmation. For this purpose, admission confirmation shall mean:
 - i. Payment of the admission fee (**INR 1,53,500.00** excluding hostel rent and mess advance). **Since students have paid partially to JOSAA, the paid amount should be deducted from INR 1,53,500.00 and the remaining amount should be paid to IIITG for admission confirmation.**
 - ii. Uploading the payment receipts for the payment **INR 1,53,500.00** as a single PDF file through the prescribed **Admission Google Form** (refer admission page).
 - iii. The timestamp of the submission of the payment receipts (uploaded through the prescribed link) shall be considered for determining the chronological order of admission confirmation and, accordingly, the allotment of on-campus hostel accommodation. Academic section will provide the detailed list of the candidates after payment verification from the account section. Chief warden will consider the timestamp of the payment verified candidates only.
- e. **It is to be noted here that** only students who have paid the IIITG full tuition fee of INR 1,53,500.00 will be considered for hostel allotment. Partial payment will not be considered as admission confirmation. Students will get a copy of their responses filled in the Google Form
- f. Students who cannot be accommodated on campus shall be provided with information regarding **an empanelled Paying Guest (PG)** accommodation facilities arranged by the Institute within approximately 4 km from the institute. However, availing the **empanelled PG** accommodation is not compulsory for first-year students. Students whose parents/guardians can arrange suitable alternative accommodation may opt out of the empanelled PG facility.

III. Acceptance of Allotted Accommodation.

- a. Students shall be required to accept the hostel room allotted to them.



- b. Requests for a change of room or hostel accommodation from students or their parents/guardians shall ordinarily not be entertained during the allotment process.

IV. Mutual Room Exchange

- a. After completion of the admission process and after students have had sufficient time to familiarize themselves with the hostel environment, requests for mutual room exchange may be considered by the hostel authorities, subject to the approval of the concerned Warden/Chief Warden.

V. Future On-Campus Accommodation

- a. Students who are unable to secure on-campus hostel accommodation during their first year shall be provided on-campus hostel accommodation from the 3rd semester (second year) onwards, subject to the Institute's hostel allotment policy.

The decision of the Institute regarding hostel accommodation allotment shall be final and binding on all students.
