Introduction



The Institute was established in 2013 and the first batch of students were admitted in August 2013. The third batch of 60 UG students joined the Institute in August 2015. With the admission of 20 PhD students in August 2015 and January 2016, the total student strength of the Institute reached 204 in 2015-16. 11 Faculty and 3 Staff were recruited in 2015-16, bringing the total faculty to 28 and the total staff strength to 17.

Classes and the office continued to function from two floors of a building in the campus of the Assam Textile Institute, GNB Road, Guwahati. Students and faculty stayed in hired flats in Shine Heaven Flat Complex, Baghorbori, Guwahati. 32 flats were taken on lease in the complex.

Construction started in the campus at Sontola near the airport in December 2015. In the beginning of the year, architectural consultants, M/S Mriduanjali and Associates were appointed through a tender process.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Mr. Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of the campus on 19th January, 2016 in the presence of the following: i) Mr. P. B. Acharya, Governor of Assam, ii) Mr. Tarun Gogoi, Chief Minister of Assam, iii) Mrs. Smriti Irani, Union HRD Minister, iv) Mr. Sarbananda Sonowal, Union Minister of State for Sports and Youth Affairs, v) Mr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister for DONER, vi) Mr. Sarat Barkotoky, Assam Education Minister, and vi) Mr. Vivek Oberoi, Secretary, MHRD, Govt. of India.

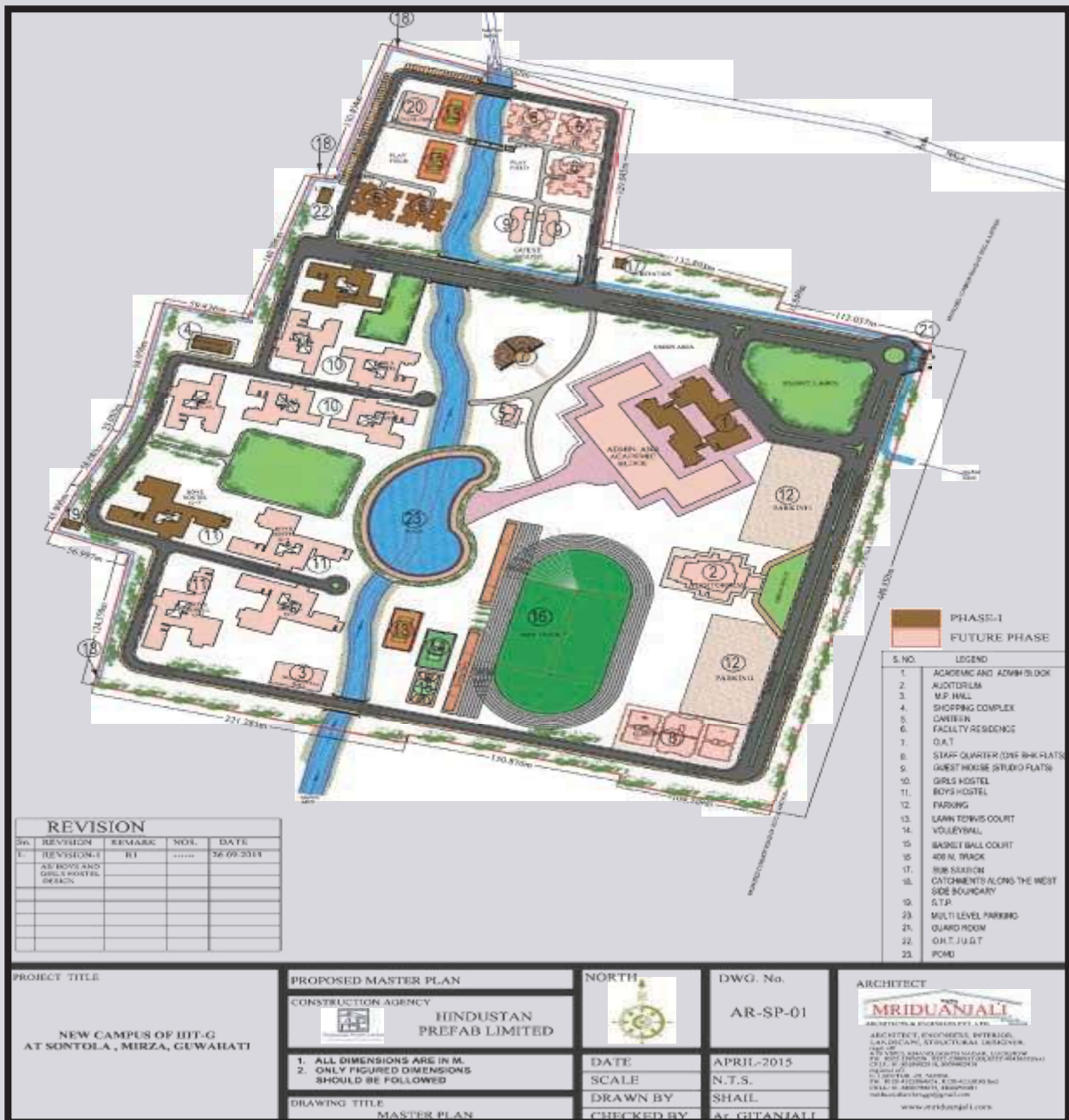
